Reap Benefit is a nonprofit organization based in Bengaluru, India, equipping youth with 21st-century skills to drive change in their local communities. Reap Benefit partners with Team4Tech to use low-code standard technology, behavioral science, AI, and machine learning to strengthen their learner platform. In 2025, Team4Tech volunteers improved Reap Benefit's tech platform, design a playbook to create sustained engagement with learners using WhatsApp, and create an AI mentorship chatbot.
